



## **DANCEBERMUDA 2010 CODE OF CONDUCT FORM**

DanceBermuda is an educational experience for our students. Students are expected to assume responsibility for their behavior and conduct. Students are expected to acquaint themselves with and abide by the rules, procedures and standards of conduct established by the NDFB and ABT, any modified to said rules made during the programme. A student whose conduct is not consistent with these standards and rules will be subject to disciplinary action, up to and including dismissal from the programme.

The standards of conduct include but are not limited to the following prohibitions:

- Use, possession, or impairment by illegal drugs and alcohol;
- Use of tobacco products;
- Possession or use of prescription medications in a manner not prescribed by a medical professional, or the misuse and abuse of prescription and/or over-the-counter medication;
- Possession or use of weapons of any nature, fireworks, or an article that can be used in a dangerous or menacing manner;
- Intimate physical or sexual contact or activity with others;
- Unexcused tardiness or absence from one or more attendance checks, classes, rehearsals, performances, and other scheduled activities;
- Gambling, participating in lotteries or any other games of chance at any time;
- Threats, disruptive or disorderly conduct, including horseplay or hazing;
- Injury to the persons or property of others, including but not limited to theft;
- Creating a dangerous or hazardous condition;
- Harassing, discriminatory or abusive conduct or language;
- Violations of law of Bermuda, or of the safety rules, practices, or other policies, procedures, and rules as set out by the NDFB and ABT;
- Permitting unauthorized visitors into BHS facilities, a host home, Fairmont Hamilton Princess or any other guest location;
- Falsification of records or documents submitted to the Programme; and
- Failure to comply with a staff member's request.

In addition, students must adhere to the following:

- Students staying at a host home, Fairmont Hamilton Princess or other guest location must abide by the Code of Conduct at all times.
- Students are required to attend all classes, rehearsals, and performances, and must notify the chaperone or, if in class, a Programme Assistant and a teacher, if they are not feeling well. Students must report any accident or illness to the chaperone and/or the Programme Coordinator.
- Students are not allowed to leave BHS facilities during the lunch hour without permission from the chaperone and/or the Programme Coordinator.
- Students are expected to treat students, BHS, Fairmont Hamilton Princess, NDFB and ABT staff in a courteous and respectful manner at all times.
